Call to Order:

Commissioner Kelly Bisson called the meeting to order at 10:06 am, June 12th, 2021.

Agenda Points:

Commissioner Bisson and Paquette reviewed the proposed six (6) Warrant Articles and answered any questions concerning these.

Public Input:

Sara Mraz asked for clarification on the language "raise and appropriate" located in warrant articles as it relates to funds. Commissioner Paquette clarified that it does not mean any increase in tax. It does mean that funds continue to be collected and allocated from residents at the same rate through the tax collection process.

Commissioners Bisson and Paquette clarified language regarding legal language regarding appropriating unused/unreserved funds from previous year to use in the current budget year as it relates to pool and road repairs funds.

Community members asked various questions about the next season plow contract situation and had questions about CCVD plow truck and equipment capability and serviceability. Commissioners Bisson and Paquette explained what the CRV, Capital Reserve Fund, is for. They also indicated that we are actively looking for a new contractor, and can now consider qualified residents to use available CCVD equipment to fulfill the plow work requirements.

Amos Green updated the community on the pool status. Contact has been made to various companies for repair/maintenance. Amos is actively seeking companies to visit and address the pool repair situation. More information will be provided as it is received by the pool committee.

Community member asked about the status of the Community Building. Currently there are a number of safety issues preventing use of the building. At this time there is no action being taken with the community building. Community member asked about structural issues, liability issues, insurance and responsibility of previous contractors. Commissioner Paquette explained that due to priority issues such as the water system and road repair, any active funds will be utilized for these areas as needed.

Community member asked about CCVD loan and bond history. Commissioner Bisson clarified and detailed what we utilized for grants, bonds and current loans. We are also working with DES and actively seeking future funding for water system repairs, upgrades and maintenance.

Community member inquired about the dissolution of CCVD. Commissioners indicated that that issue is still on the table and being researched. It is an ongoing issue requiring extensive discussion and community input.

Commissioner Bisson opened the floor for nominations for CCVD open positions.

Bria Seay nominated herself for Secretary. Zachary Paquette Seconded.

Amos Green nominated himself for Commissioner. Bria Seay seconded.

Sara Mraz nominated herself for Moderator. Bria Seay seconded.
