April 24, 2014

Present: Sherry Cullimore, Crissa Evans and Cathy Orlowicz.

The meeting started at 7pm at Town Hall. There was a discussion regarding Peter Michaud's talk at Strawberry Banke on 'Historic Preservation and Conservation'. He talked about the Secretary of the Interior's Standards and the treatment of Historic Properties. Cathy contacted him about coming to talk to us about the reconstruction of the Boodey House. We added some of the information on what we had done this year. She will rewrite it and email it to us to check us out. Sherry will check with Carole Ingham about buying a checklist to get addresses. Cathy can copy the list for us. We do have money in the budget for stamps.

Next meeting we need to work on our marketing and business plan.

Crissa brought in a news clipping of some 18th buildings being moved in Arundel, ME.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30pm.
