STATEMENT OF POLICY NEW DURHAM WEB SITE HYPERLINK

The Town of New Durham has its own web site relating to town activities, policies, permits and general government information. In order to remain non-partisan, unbiased, and fair, the Town of New Durham hereby adopts the following policy with respect to hyper linking of its web site, and approves of:

- □ Links to other Town of New Durham associated web sites.
- □ Federal, State, regional and local government web sites.
- Non-partisan web sites that encourage the informed and active participation of Town of New Durham residents in government.
- □ Museums, libraries, churches, and other cultural organizations that benefit New Durham residents.
- □ Non-profit, community and human service organizations that benefit New Durham residents.
- Any New Durham Business Associations or Chambers of Commerce or the same for local abutting communities
- Public and Private Schools, and post secondary institutions.
- Special Events (normally short-lived such as the Meetinghouse or Old Home Day) web sites that are consistent with at least one of the categories listed above.
