Prohibited Practices in Municipal Buildings  
TO.03-016

The following Ordinance has been enacted by the Selectmen of New Durham, NH pursuant to powers granted to them in RSA 41:11.

1. Firearms prohibited in municipal buildings:

It shall be unlawful for any person to have a firearm in his or her possession at any time while within any municipal building in the Town of New Durham.

2. Exceptions:

- a. The prohibitions established in Section A shall not apply to bona fide federal, state, county or local law enforcement officials.
- b. The Chief of Police is authorized to grant advance written permission to allow any individual or organization demonstrating good reason to possess a firearm within a municipal building with permission to do so under such terms and conditions as the Chief may require.

3. Penalty:

The penalty for violation of this provision may be up to a \$1,000 fine.

4. Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall become effective May 1, 2003
