Road / Utility Construction

The following Ordinance has been enacted by the Selectmen of New Durham, NH pursuant to the powers granted them in RSA 41:11 and RSA 47:17 (VII) and RSA 236:10.

CONSTRUCTION WORK REQUIRING UNIFORMED POLICEMEN:

1. Prior to the commencement of "road improvements" or prior to the laying or relaying of electrical , telephone or any type of telecommunications equipment , cable TV , or any other type of underground utilities or the installation of above-ground utilities which would interfere with the normal and regular flow of traffic within the Town of New Durham, the primary contractor responsible for the conduct of the work performed upon the site , will be required to employ uniformed policemen to control traffic provided any of the following conditions exist:
 - a. Any construction which will significantly affect the flow of traffic.
2. In addition to the conditions enumerated above , the Chief of Police and / or Road Agent may , in their discretion , require the primary contractor to employ uniformed policemen when the construction is such as to unreasonably interfere with the normal and ordinary flow of traffic or presents conditions which adversely affect public safety and convenience.


PENALTY:


In the event that any of the above provisions are violated, the Chief of Police and / or Road Agent is empowered to issue a work stoppage order against the contractor or his employees; such work stoppage order shall remain in effect until there is strict compliance with this ordinance. In addition a civil forfeiture shall be issued in the amount of \$250.00 for the first offense and for each successive offense a civil forfeiture of \$500.00. This will be paid to the Town of New Durham at the Town Clerks Office within 15 days of issuance. Failure to comply with this procedure will result in a summons to the Rochester District Court.




This Ordinance shall become effective May 1, 2003
